Classes

Open section, For fanicers who have won 1st at an North Island Affiliated Poultry And Pigeon Show.

Novice, for the newcomer. If you have not had a bird of any breed or type Placed 1 or 2nd at an open show.

Junior, Open to all Juniors from ages 5 to 16.

<u>Classes:</u> If more than 6 of any specific breed of chicken, duck, or pigeon are entered, they will be split into a class:

Open Section – Entry Fee \$3 per Bird. Open to all pure breeds poultry and pigeons only.

- 1. Game Birds including Bantams Male
- 2. Game Birds Including Bantams Female
- 3. Heavy Breed Males
- 4. Heavy Breed Female
- 5. Bantams Males
- 6. Bantams Female
- 7. Light Breed Males
- 8. Light Breed Females
- 9. Waterfowl Drake
- 10. Waterfowl Duck
- 11. Pigeons. This class will be split according to entries.

Novice section. \$3 per bird entry fee.

Novice section of Purebred stock only. This section is only open to competitors who have never been Placed 1^{st} or 2^{nd} at a North Island Affiliated show.

- 12. Female Light or Heavy breed (if more than 6 entries will be split into heavy & light?
- 13. Male Light or heavy breed
- 14. Bantams/Game Birds Male all breeds
- 15. Bantams/Game Birds Female all breeds.
- 16. Waterfowl Drake all breeds
- 17. Waterfowl Duck all breeds
- 18. Pigeons

Junior section. \$3 per bird

- 19. Game Birds Male or Female
- 20. Heavy Breed Male or Female
- 21. Light Breed Male or Female
- 22. Bantams Male or Female
- 23. Waterfowl Drake or Duck
- 24. Pigeons

Best bird in each section goes forwards for Champion and Reserve Champion.

All Classes, in all sections. Birds placed (1st, 2nd, 3rd) will receive a special card or ribbon.

General Rules & Conditions

- 1. The Rules and Regulations as issued by the Royal Agricultural Society of New Zealand (Inc.) for the governance and conduct of A & P Shows have been adopted by the Manawatu & West Coast A&P Association. It is the responsibility of exhibitors to be conversant with these rules. Copies of the Rules and Regulations are available on request.
- 2. Entries are accepted on the clear understanding that Rules will be adhered to. Arrears & Entries: The Committee reserves the right to limit or refuse any entries. If any entry is refused, entry fees will be refunded in full. A person who is in arrears to this or any other affiliated show with regard to entry fees, subscriptions, or other fees, is ineligible to enter and compete at this or any other affiliated show. Proof of payment is required before any restriction is lifted. Entry Refunds: Requests must be in writing, with Dr's or Vet's certificate, and will be less 25% administration costs.
- 3. The committee reserves the right to make any alteration to the Show timetable, or to postpone the Show, or withdraw any event as may be deemed desirable.
- 4. Depending on entries at closing date, classes may be cancelled, split, or combined if appropriate
- 5. **The RAS Yellow and Red Card** (updated 2023) *This Show supports the RAS 'Yellow and Red Card' system*. An explanation of the new rules under the yellow and red system can be found at Our Rules, Regulations and Policies Royal Agricultural Society New Zealand (ras.org.nz)
- 6. **The RAS Resolution Process** can be found on the RAS website, as above. The principle behind the process is to deal with the matter as it comes to hand and in most cases it should be dealt with directly by the show. If the

matter is in regards to a RAS official, the show may request the assistance of RAS Head Office as to how to deal with this in an appropriate manner.

7. The show would prefer that **dogs** are not brought onto the grounds; but if you do bring a dog it <u>MUST be on a lead and controlled at all times</u>. The car racing circuit and its environs are strictly out of bounds for dogs.

HEALTH & SAFETY

• "The Manawatu A&P Association is required to conform to the **Health and Safety at Work Act 2015** and any amendments; therefore, you are required to carry out your work or undertaking on the Manfeild Park premises to comply with this Act. As a show exhibitor at this venue, you are obligated to accept responsibility for ensuring a safe showing venue within the focus of the Act. As a user of these facilities, you are required to manage and supervise all your activities and live animal exhibits to ensure the good Health and Safety of all people involved in the show, at all times.

Health & Safety Specific Requirements:

- All vehicles, caravans and floats requiring power <u>must</u> have a Warrant of Electrical Fitness that meets legislation standard AS/NZS 3001.
- Any and all electrical equipment, including extension power leads, must be <u>tested and tagged with a current tag.</u>(Standard AS/NZS3760)
- Vehicles and leads may be checked during the show, on a strictly 'user pays' basis.
- Anyone bringing in, or in charge of the use of any motorized bike, two, three or four wheeled, must be trained in its use and must wear a safety helmet at ALL times when using it. As Manfeild Park is a public place, bike riders must have a current Drivers' License. Quad bikes must not carry passengers, and no-one under the age of 16 is permitted to operate a quad bike.
- Motorbike riders must observe a speed limit of 20 km/hour at all times, anywhere on the showgrounds.
