- Enter dogs in preferred order.
- A call off may be applied if needed.
- Should entries exceed the number that can be accommodated, selection will be made from those with multiple entries and last to enter

LEGAL LIABILITY/ SUPERVISION & CONTROL OF ANIMAL/S:

- The Association's insurance policy does not cover Competitors or Exhibitors. Each exhibitor must supervise and control their animals at all times and shall be liable for any hazard created or accident, illness or damage caused by the action of themselves or their animals at the Showgrounds.
