#### **RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION**

- Please bring your Entries to the front desk in the stadium foyer at Manfeild Park between 10.00 am and 12.00 pm on Friday 1<sup>st</sup> November. They will be judged on Friday Afternoon.
- Each exhibit in the each section must have attached to it a sealed envelope containing the name of the exhibitor (inside) and the class number from the schedule on the outside. In the event of noncompliance with this rule, exhibits may be refused for the competition. Each entrant should have completed an entry form prior to the day.
- Baking entries to be on a cardboard/plastic plate, in a plastic bag
- Each exhibitor is to provide their own jar or bottle container for each home flower garden entry
- Photographs to be 100mm x 150mm (4' x 6'); mounted on card with a 25mm border, with your name, Class no, and contact details on the back
- > Entries must be the bona fide work of the exhibitor
- Maximum 2 entries per person per class
- > The Judge's decision is final and absolute

Entry Fees: \$3.00 per entry.

Prize Money: 1<sup>st</sup> \$15.00 2<sup>nd</sup> \$10.00 3<sup>rd</sup> \$5.00

Sponsored prizes may be given in lieu of Prize money.

**Note:** Prize Money for the Adults Section will be paid by internet banking after the show. Prize Money for the Children's/teenager Section can be collected at the show on Saturday, between 1.30 and 5.00pm, or collected from the show office during the week after the show. Entries can be removed from 4.00pm onwards on Saturday 2nd.

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\* A special feature Class: 2021 – an Un-iced Christmas cake, no smaller than 200mm. (all ages).
